To successfully complete the Challenge all you have to do is complete a minimum number of actions from each section.



SECTION ONEIntroduction and Discussion

As a group discuss the following:

- What is litter?
- Why do people litter?
- The negative impact of litter
- Who is responsible for dealing with litter?
- How can we prevent litter?



SECTION TWO Research

Complete two actions (minimum):

- Find out what we should do with our rubbish
- Keep a food waste diary at home
- Find out how much food and packaging waste your school produces in a week
- Research the total waste you generate
- Choose a product and design your own packaging
- Design a pest and weather-proof bin



SECTION THREE Activities

Complete three actions (minimum):

- Redd up an untidy area
- Raise awareness of local littering
- Litter Scavenger Hunt
- Recycling games
- Tour of Enviroglass to see what happens to our waste glass
- Bruck to Bling exhibition,
 Sale or Fashion Show
- Plan and host a No Waste Party!
