Information for Teachers and Group Leaders



The Dunna Chuck Bruck Challenge is a fantastic resource for use within your school or youth club. The online Challenge Pack contains lots of supporting materials including images, litter facts, activity ideas and links to useful websites. These materials are intended to aid discussion and inspire your class or group to identify and tackle environmental issues relevant to them and their local community.

How to complete the Challenge

The Dunna Chuck Bruck Challenge is divided into three sections: Introduction & Discussion, Research and Activities. To complete the Challenge participants must complete Section One: Introduction & Discussion, a minimum of 2 actions from Section Two: Research and a minimum of 3 actions from Section Three: Activities. The Challenge is flexible enough that you can adapt or build on any of the actions to suit your group. The Challenge Pack is an online resource allowing you to choose which parts you want to print and use – we're all about reducing waste! In the Pack you will find:
